Between 2013 and 2018 Camillo worked as Emergency Medicine doctor at the London North-West University Healthcare NHS Trust. In 2017-18 he worked both as a research officer and an EM doctor for the African Federation for Emergency Medicine. In 2017-18, as Director of Tessellate and recipient of a D-prize for global social entrepreneurship, he worked on a new mechanism to digitize the vaccine supply chain in Zambia, building Zambia's first SMS-to-Web interface. In 2019 he was a part-time Research Assistant at the Kirby Institute (U. of New South Wales) and created an algorithm that, by consolidating over 600 spreadsheets into a single one, allowed him to analyse statistically data from a clinical trial.
